

VISA Information:

A valid passport is required for entry into Zimbabwe. Citizens of certain countries are required to obtain visas for entry into Zimbabwe.

The list of such countries changes from time to time, so it is important to check with your local authorities or travel consultant regarding current visa requirements.

Visas can be obtained for a fee of \$30-00 at Harare International Airport, on the day of your arrival in Zimbabwe.

If you intend to travel through or visit South Africa, be aware that South African law requires travelers to have two (2) blank (unstamped) pages in their passport to enter the country. Travelers without the requisite blank visa pages in their passports may be refused entry into South Africa, fined and returned to their point of origin at their own expense.

A letter of invitation will be issued to you in order to assist with your Travel Arrangements and Gun clearance through Johannesburg (Oliver Tambo) International Airport.

Medical Information
